Gulfstream Goodwill Industries (GGI) is a private, nonprofit agency serving Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Indian River and Okeechobee counties for over 55 years. We are the largest homelessness provider in our five-county region and the largest health and human services organization in our territory. Last year, we served 1,500 homeless individuals, helping to get them off the streets and into a safe environment. What makes Goodwill different is that we believe in the dignity and power of work — providing “a hand up, not a handout.” We are providing individuals with a better life!

The second annual *Gulfstream: Drive to Provide* will take place on Friday, February 16th at The Lake Pavilion in downtown West Palm Beach at 5pm and is hosted by the Gulfstream Region Porsche Club of America. Proceeds from the event are earmarked for GGI’s homelessness prevention and disability services. Every night, we have over 300 individuals in our four shelters who would otherwise be on the streets. We also have a charter school and day training program, for students and adults with intellectual disabilities, to provide job training and employment. WHAT OTHER SERVICES DOES GGI PROVIDE?

GGI is changing lives through housing, training, education and employment. Our mission is to assist people with disabilities who are homeless or have other barriers to employment to become self-sufficient, working members of the South Florida community. We have 20+ programs including our microenterprises, Good Prints Shop and Good Grub, who will actually be catering some of the food at *Drive to Provide*. We also have Adult Training Programs for adults who have developmental disabilities that enhance job skills, provide personal growth and promote health and wellness. A lot of people may not realize that we also have a charter school, The Career Academy of the Palm Beaches. The school serves students with disabilities ages 16-21, providing them with the skills necessary for adult life so that each individual will be an independent, self-sufficient and contributing community member. Some recent graduates have been employed at our own Good Prints Shop as well as Eau Palm Beach Resort & Spa, The Seagate

Hotel and The Boca Raton Country Club. These are only a few of our many initiatives that help the most critically in need in our local communities.
